The course focuses on the Sherman Act, the Clayton Act and the Federal Trade Commission Act (Antitrust Laws) and how they apply to an organisation and their employees.

UK Anti-Competitive Conduct focuses on the UK Competition Act 1998 which outlaws anti competitive practices and the Enterprise Act 2002 which covers the criminal sanctions applied to individuals who dishonestly engage in cartel arrangements such as price fixing, limiting supply or production, market sharing or bid rigging.
