

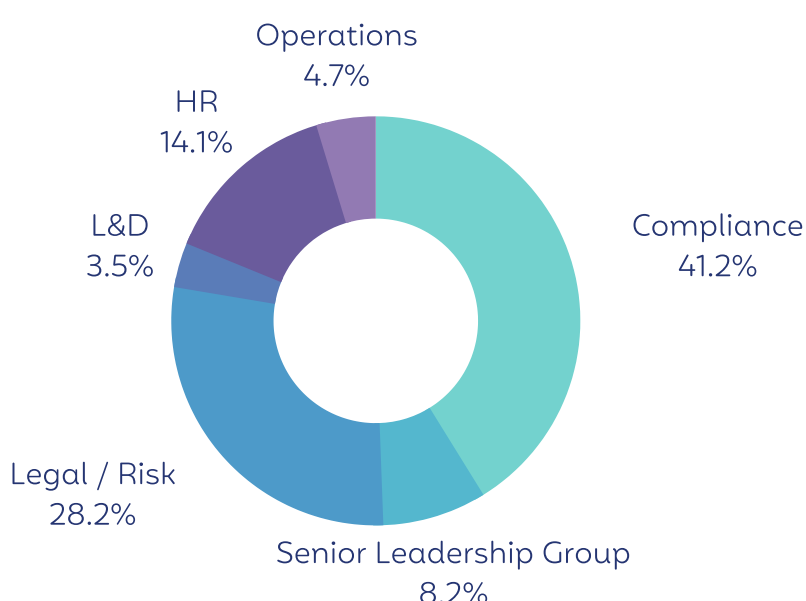
OUTLOOK FOR COMPLIANCE IN 2021

COMPLIANCE RESPONSIBILITY

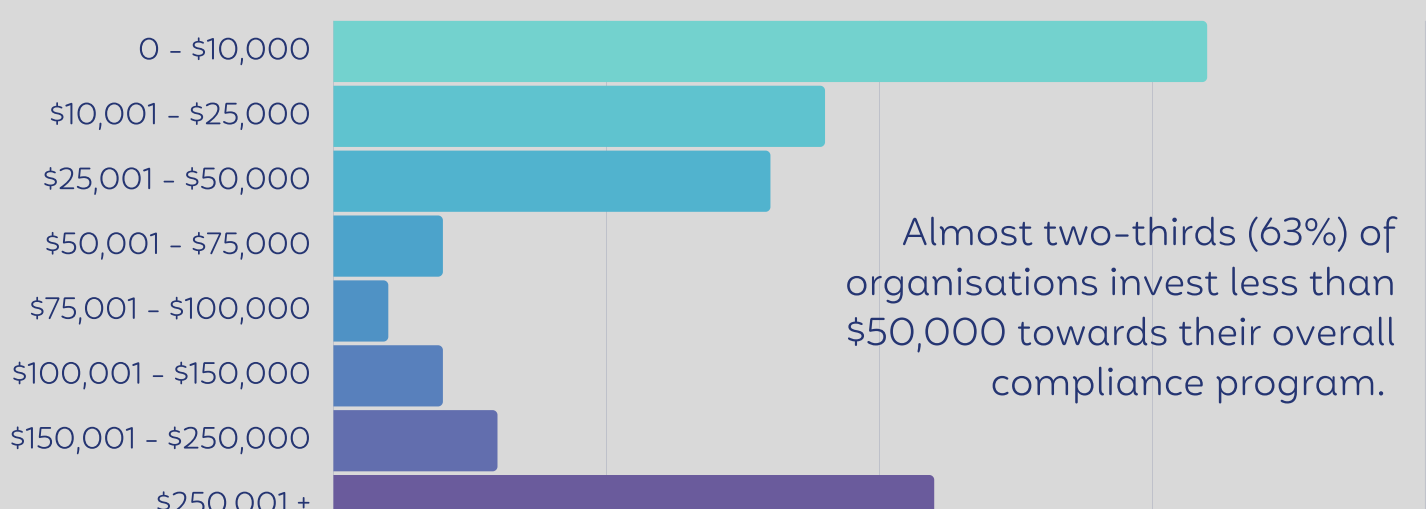
More than two-thirds (69%) of organisations have their compliance, legal and risk departments responsible/accountable for compliance in their organisation.



84% of organisations have introduced new policies as a result of COVID-19



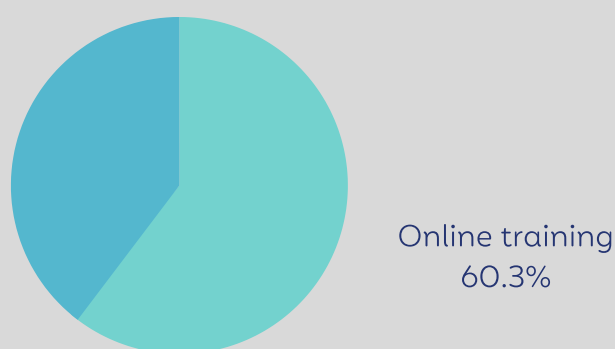
COMPLIANCE BUDGET



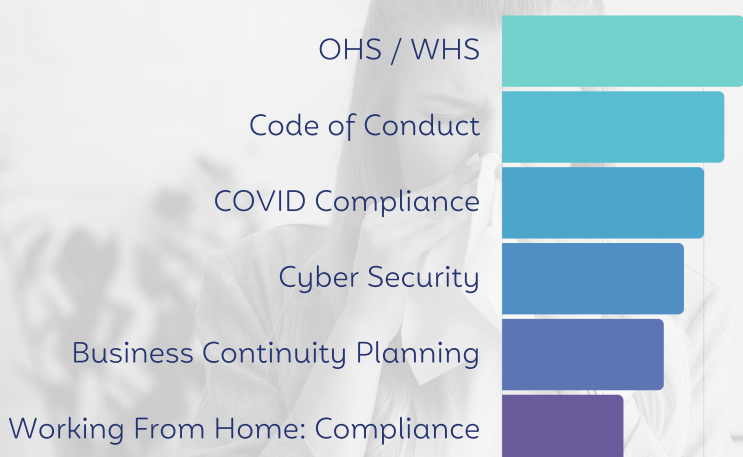
More than one-third of organisations spend their budget on Face-to-Face compliance training.

However, 60% of organisations have said they are shifting their compliance priorities, with most stating COVID-19 and the impact on WHS/OHS as the reason for the shift, and a view towards going to online training.

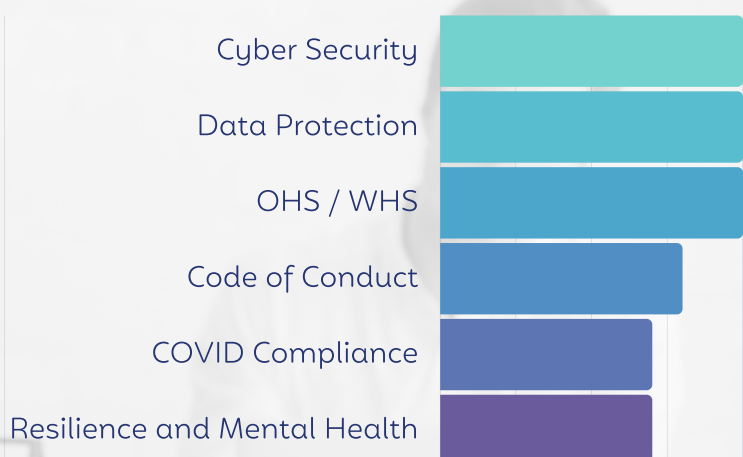
Face-to-Face training

COMPLIANCE PRIORITIES



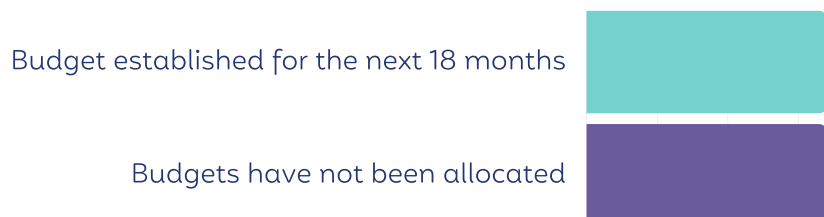
Next 3-6 months

COMPLIANCE IN THE FUTURE



More than half (56%) believe the compliance function will increase in the next five years. The remainder believes it will stay the same.

Of those who believe it will increase, they expect the compliance function to rise by two-thirds.
